<u>Pray for the Persecuted Church in NIGERIA (7)</u> Church Minister Abducted and Murdered in Kaduna State

Please pray for the family and church community of Sylvester Okechukwu, church minister in Kaduna State, whose murder was reported on March 5.

Okechukwu, who ministered at a church in the Kaura Local Government Area, was kidnapped from his residence on the evening of March 4. His body was found the following morning. A spokesman from the Diocese of Kafanchan described Sylvester as "a dedicated servant of God, who worked selflessly in the vineyard of the Lord, spreading the message of peace, love, and hope."

"This untimely and brutal loss has left us heartbroken and devastated," he added._The minister's abduction occurred just two days after two others were kidnapped in Edo State on March 2. Church leaders have frequently been targeted by criminal gangs and extremist groups.

Pray:

That God will surround Sylvester's family and congregation with His love and enable them to know His closeness even as they feel crushed in spirit (Psalm 34:18).

That they will stand firm in their faith in the midst of their grief. Ask the Lord for protection of the shepherds of His flock in Nigeria, that extremists' plans to abduct and harm church leaders will be defeated.

NIGERIAN CHRISTIANS CALL FOR END TO CARNAGE AS EASTER ATTACKS CLAIM 72 LIVES

Thousands of Christians took part in a peaceful march against rising Islamist violence in Nigeria's Middle Belt on April 21, as the death toll in the latest slaughter rose to 72.

Suspected Fulani Islamist militants carried out assaults on Christian communities in Ukum and Logo Local Government Areas (LGAs) of Benue State on April 17 and into Good Friday, April 18. Initially, it was feared 56 people had been killed; however, the number climbed to 72 as more bodies were recovered from the bush.

"We are under siege as a state, we are under attack," said Benue State governor Hyacinth Alia after he attended a church service on April 21. "They come, they drag people out, they kill to occupy." He added, "A terrorist is a terrorist irrespective of his ethnicity or his religion. Criminality is criminality, period. So, whoever commits it is a terrorist, and he should not be where the living are."

Just as Governor Alia was speaking, demonstrators in neighboring Plateau State expressed anger and grief over renewed anti-Christian violence that claimed more than 100 lives in <u>Bokkos</u> and <u>Bassa</u> LGAs in the first two weeks of April.

Thousands marched peacefully through the state capital, Jos, to Government House, many carrying placards that read "The ground cries blood," "We deserve to live," and "No more silence, peace now." "We are tired of mass burials," said Pastor Amos Mozho, chairman of the Denominational Leaders Forum, which organized the rally. "Enough is enough," he added.

Pastor Mozho rejected claims that the attacks were communal farmer-herder clashes, stating the violence was a coordinated onslaught against the people of Plateau. "This is not a communal crisis," he insisted. "It is a brutal campaign against innocent lives in Plateau."

Pray for all those who have been bereaved, injured or displaced by the ongoing violence in Middle Belt, Nigeria. Ask the Lord to restore the bodies, minds and spirits of His persecuted people. Pray for protection for everyone at risk of attack, especially our brothers and sisters in Christ. Ask that peace is restored to this troubled region.
